Rolesville Parks and Recreation Advisory Board Meeting Unapproved Minutes July 28, 2021

1. CALL TO ORDER - CHAIR

At 7:06 pm July 28, 2021, Terry Ratliff, Chair, called the meeting to order.

Attending tonight's meeting were JG Ferguson, Parks and Recreation Director; members Terry Ratliff, Chair; Kevin Mazur, Vice Chair; Mary Ka Powers; Derek Versteegen; Paul Vilga, Town Board Liaison.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion made by Mary Ka to approve minutes as presented, seconded by Kevin Mazur. The motion carried unanimously.

4. NEW BUSINESS

Bond Proposal

JG plans to present bond proposal information to the Board of Commissioners during their next meeting. PARAB members will hold another Zoom meeting to discuss how to present relevant information to the community and work through a survey.

Youth Football Program

JG showed the current and past participation numbers. Those numbers have been trending down to the point of not having a team in all three age groups for the last 3 years. This year only 14 participants registered for youth football. The PARAB is recommending elimination of the youth football program based on its program life cycle and current national youth football trends. The PARAB would like to staff to look at alternative programs to replace youth football.

Chandler Ridge Development-Future Park Land Option

The Town of Rolesville has the option to purchase additional park land. The Town has until May 1, 2022 to work with the developer to agree to acreage and price. PARAB will review and revisit in November to further discuss future needs and the feasibility of this park land.

Bond – Calendar of Work to be Completed by PARAB

The PARAB continues to support the bond for the Farm project. PARAB will recommend to the Town Board at the August meeting putting out the bond referendum for the full amount to complete Phase I of development.

Cobblestone/Community Center

JG gave an update on the Cobblestone Project and the Community Center, which is part of that project. Staff is working with CPL for concept design to be presented to the Town Board for feedback in September.

Open Space & Greenway Plan

McAdams is continuing to work on the OSAG Plan and the survey is nearing completion. Next steering committee meeting will be in October.

4. NEW BUSINESS

Welcome New Members

Aaron and Dick introduced to the board as the newest members. Mary Ka and Abby reappointed for new terms.

Nominations for Vice Chair and Secretary

Due to additions to the board late in the year, Mary Ka made the motion to keep current positions as they are: Terry as Chair, Kevin as Vice Chair. Derek seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. The board will nominate a Secretary at the September meeting.

Bond Proposal

Terry and Kevin were at the Town Board meeting on August 17th. Terry updated the Town Board on the work PARAB has done to date. The Town Board was receptive and acknowledged they need to initiate progress. Terry relayed the wishes of PARAB and recommended the Town move forward with the complete Phase I project as presented.
