

Proclamation of the Town of Rolesville DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY CONSENT TO WAKE COUNTY PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

March 13, 2020

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death by the SARS-Co-V-2 Virus. This is a new strain of coronavirus previously unidentified in humans which can spread from person to person; and

WHEREAS, The Governor of the State of North Carolina, in consultation with the Secretary of the NCDHHS, has declared a State of Emergency as defined by N.C. Gen. Stat. 166A-19.3(6) and 166A-19.3(19) for the State of North Carolina based on the public health emergency posed by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Wake County Government is responsible for emergency management throughout the County, including the coordination of activities of municipalities within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Wake County Public Health Director has confirmed a public health threat due to the confirmed spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services ("NCDHHS") has confirmed multiple cases of COVID-19 in the State, including in Wake County; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the Honorable Gregory D. Ford, chairman of the Wake County Board of Commissioners, did proclaim a State of Emergency for Wake County; and

WHEREAS, Wake County has requested the Town's consent to the extension of the emergency area of the Wake County proclamation so as to include the Town of Rolesville.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me pursuant to Section 166A-19.22(b) of the North Carolina General Statutes, I do hereby consent to the extension of the emergency area of the Wake County proclamation to include the entirety of the Town of Rolesville.

This Consent shall become effective immediately upon execution and shall continue until modified or rescinded as provided by law.
