- Secretary takes minutes for meetings to be submitted to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board for review



### Landmark Trees

#### 6.2.5.12. TREE PROTECTION

The Town of Rolesville Tree Board shall locate, select, and identify any trees which qualify as "Landmark Trees." A tree may qualify as a Landmark Tree if it meets one or more of the following criteria: species rarity, old age, association with an historical event or person, abnormality, scenic enhancement, etc. The following guidelines and standards shall apply to trees proposed to be retained in a developer's "tree protection plan": not grading or locating utilities within the tree's drip line, placing protective barriers around trees, etc. in association with Section 6.2.4: Landscaping Standards









## N Main St Greenway Tulip Poplar

- Suggested motion The large tulip poplar tree located in front of 405
  N Main St along the N Main St Greenway will be selected as the Town's first Landmark Tree
- Coordinates of tree: 35°55'41.2"N 78°27'03.4"W
- Due to it's size and age, because it is an excellent specimen of a tulip poplar tree and is native to NC

### Redford Place Drive Street Trees

- Elms were planted along Redford Place Drive as street trees around 20 years ago.
- Some trees are dead or dying and need to be replaced.
- Some potential species to replant are: red maples, oak trees, bald cypress, London planetrees, redbuds and dogwoods
