How and where do I register for a program or athletic league?

Register in Town Hall or on our website, just look for "Event/Class Registration".

When can I register for programs?

For programs that require it, registration typically opens 6 to 8 weeks before the program start date and ends one week before the program start date. We have some programs that operate on a "drop-in" basis. Check the program description for details.

When can I register for an athletic league?

Athletic program registration must be done during the resident and/or open registration periods.

How can I pay for registration?

Registrations completed online must be paid for with a credit card. Registrations completed at Town Hall may be paid by credit card, cash or check.

I signed my child up for a sports league, when will the practice/game schedules be released?

The number of teams in each league is determined by how many participants register. Once registration ends, you will be notified by email as soon as the information is available. Please remember to make sure that your contact information in your REC1 account is always up to date!

What does "R and NR" stand for?

R stands for Resident and NR stands for Non-Resident. Some, but not all programs and classes have a discounted rate for Town of Rolesville residents. A "Rolesville" address does not necessarily mean that you live in the corporate limits. Please call Parks and Recreation if you have questions.

Is there a Resident discount?

Most of our programs offer a discounted rate for Town of Rolesville residents. The discount is usually \$10 to \$15 but there are some exceptions: For youth athletics, the resident discount is \$27; for camps, the discount is \$20. Resident discounts for shelters and the community center vary by space and location.

How do I rent a facility? (park shelter or community center)

Facilities can be booked and rented online by going to www.RolesvilleNC.gov, and scrolling down to "Event/Class Registration". The Community Center at Town Hall and Mill Bridge Nature Park Amphitheatre requires an additional form be submitted first. Please call 919-554-6582.

Scholarship Program

Rolesville Parks and Recreation Department is committed to providing quality recreation programs and events to all its citizens, regardless of financial need. The purpose of this policy is to set standards for the distribution of financial assistance or scholarships for parks and recreation programs and events to Rolesville residents in need who wish to participate in Town-facilitated programming.

Financial Assistance will be made available **only** to **Rolesville residents** who are **eligible**. This assistance can be applied to registration for all recreation programming that cost more than \$15 per person. Scholarships are not available for facility reservations.

ELIGIBILITY

- In order to be eligible for assistance, applicants must demonstrate financial need with a current acceptance letter from SNAP or Medicaid or with proof that the household qualifies for free or reduced lunches at school. As funds are available, scholarships will cover 50% of the program registration costs
- One household is eligible to receive up to \$200 financial assistance each calendar year.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicants for this scholarship program must complete this application either online or at Town Hall. Applicants must attach proof of financial need to the verification form. Residents wishing to receive financial assistance for program registration costs must submit an application for each participant in their household no later than 5 business days before the registration deadline for the desired program.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Parks and Recreation Department in the order received, and applicants with verified eligibility will receive funds as they are available. Notification of scholarship application acceptance or denial will be given no later than 5 business days after receipt of application. All information contained within applications will be kept confidential and used for the sole purpose of establishing eligibility for the scholarship program.
- Applications that are approved will receive a credit on their Rec1 account in the amount determined by the department, which can be applied to registration for eligible programs. Scholarship funds used improperly will be subject to repayment and exclusion from future use of this program.

What is Juneteenth?

Juneteenth is the oldest known celebration commemorating the end of slavery in the United States. A combination of the words "June" and "nineteenth," Juneteenth commemorates Union Major General Gordon Granger's reading of the 'General Order Number 3' in the City of Galveston, Texas freeing enslaved people on June 19, 1865. The reading of 'General Order Number 3' came 2 and a half years after President Abraham Lincoln enacted the Emancipation Proclamation on September 22, 1862. News and enforcement of the proclamation had been slow to reach remote areas of the United States.

Today, Juneteenth celebrates African American freedom and achievement, while encouraging continuous self-development and respect for all cultures.





Main Street Park - MSP

200 South Main Street & 500 Scarboro Street

Located in the heart of Rolesville, Main Street Park has four rentable shelters, a gazebo, open play field, two playgrounds and over one mile of greenway trails. The shelters are first come, first served unless they have been rented ahead of time. All rentals have a two hour minimum time requirement, charcoal grills and picnic tables (except the gazebo, which has two benches). Personal grills are not allowed, nor the use of outside



entertainment (including, but not limited to, inflatables, DJ's/PA equipment, hired entertainment, pop up tents and vendors). Alcohol and tobacco products are prohibited on Town property and please, no sidewalk chalk under the shelters and/or under covered areas. Main Street Park closes at dusk.



Mill Bridge Nature Park - MBNP

Located off Rogers Rd., Mill Bridge Nature Park connects with the Wake Forest Parks & Recreation Greenways and, in the future, will provide connection all the way to Main Street Park. 
