This memo summarizes the review of the Construction Infrastructure Documents submitted by ARK Consulting Group, dated 04/01/2024 (received 04/03/2024).

### Sheet CO.1

- 1. Update the project number on the title sheet with the Rolesville project number: CID 24-03.
- 2. In the sheet index, the reference survey from Johnson, Mirmiran & Thompson shows there are four sheets included. There are only three sheets included for this survey in the plan set. Include the fourth sheet or update the sheet index.

### Sheet CO.2

- 3. Label all the existing rights-of-way shown with name and width.
  - a. This comment applies to subsequent sheets.
- 4. Please label all the easements shown on the existing conditions sheet. Provide deed book, page number, owner, and width.
- 5. The previously approved Wall Creek Drive improvements are shown on subsequent sheets. If these will be existing during the time of construction, and the design of Lot 8 is based on these design contours, the design contours should also be shown on sheet C0.2 for consistency, as existing contours.
- 6. Please include in the existing pipe labels, including the pipe size, for all of the pipes adjacent and within the lot.
- 7. Provide the metes and bounds for the property.
- 8. Label the existing creek with the creek name and label the riparian buffer.
- 9. Adjust the overlapping labels to allow for legibility.
  - a. This comment applies to all sheets.
- 10. Please provide additional information on the Temporary Construction Easement (TCE) shown; clarify if it is from a different project or a previous plat. Provide a label for the TCE accordingly.

#### Sheet C1.1

11. The upstream invert for the temporary diversion ditch shown appears to be higher or at the existing ground elevation level. Provide the minimum ditch depth.

- a. Wake County to provide final approval on all erosion control plans.
- 12. Silt fence outlets will need to be provided along the low side of the site to account for all the drainage not being routed to the sediment basin.
  - a. Wake County to provide final approval on all erosion control plans.

# Sheet C1.2

- 13. Based on shown contours, the highlighted area on the markups is draining into the diversion ditch. Please include this area in the diversion ditch/sediment basin area shown. Alternatively, if draining off site silt fence needs to be provided.
  - a. Wake County to provide final approval on all erosion control plans.
- 14. All onsite drainage must be routed to the pond; please adjust contours or ditches accordingly.
  - a. Wake County to provide approval on all erosion control plans.
- 15. There is a small section of contours going beyond limits of disturbance; please ensure all grading is within limits of disturbance.
