We are pleased to offer this response to comments from the Town of Rolesville's review completed on June 9, 2025. Ballentine's responses are in RED below.

Planning & Zoning Comments:

- 1. Continue to Provide written responses to ALL the comments received / Bubble/cloud any revisions made / Revise all dates on all materials. -[Acknowledged, see attached.]
- 2. ADDRESSES Contact Wake Co. GIS/911 to attain addresses, and add them to each lot. -[Added.]
- 3. FYI STREETLIGHTS the submitted Lighting Plan exhibit indicates 27 street light poles -- an INVOICE for the one-time \$650/pole fee, which must be paid prior to Town signature/approval of plat, will come under separate email. -[Acknowledged.]
- 4. All Sheets Remove all "Preliminary Plat" stamps on lefthand side of all sheets within the Final Plat set. -[Acknowledged, see attached.]
- 5. NEW Sheet 1, center remove "V1", this is V2 but for recordation, delete any "V" references here in title block. -[Revised.]
- 6. REPEAT (see Red) Cover Sheet Please Provide a single Table that aligns Lot Number / Lot Address / Max. Impervious Coverage (for that lot). -[Lot table has been updated.]

Parks and Recreation:

7. Revise to add a more specific call out labeling the Town of Rolesville Public Greenway Easement. The hatching alone is not sufficient.-[Revised.]

Wake County Watershed Mgt:

8. Revisions to Construction Drawings (CD 21-08) are under review - TBD -[Acknowledged, surveyor is not involved in the construction drawing review.]

COR Public Utilities:

9. The 3' CORUE should also be called out on Sheets 3 and 4. -[Revised.]



- 10. The COR waterline easement for the water meter serving the PS should be recorded (if possible) with Phase 1 because the PS should be operational (with a WM) prior to recording these lots. –[Added.]
- 11. This easement has already been recorded. Please reference as existing. See BK 19778 PG 109. –[Corrected.]
- 12. Additional easement will need to be recorded for the 2" water meter and waterline before it reaches the proposed CORSSE. –[Acknowledged, easement not yet received from design engineer. Can this be handled with a separate recording, if necessary.]
- 13. Downstream Harris Creek Upgrades should be installed and accepted by Raleigh prior to recording lots. –[Acknowledged.]
- 14. Water/sewer and pump station should be accepted by Raleigh prior to recording of lots. –[Acknowledged.]
- 15. As discussed with the project engineer, a 3' City of Raleigh Utility Easement strip may be necessary along all of the lot frontages 1' behind the R/W is not enough room for the water meter & curb stop. –[Acknowledged, 3' COR Utility Easement is depicted and annotated along all residential lot frontages.]

NCDOT:

- 16. Town Staff: what is state of the required (off-site) roadway improvements?; are they completed and put under warranty? –[Acknowledged, status unknown to surveyor.]
- 17. NCDOT is reviewing an additional driveway to a Utility Pump Station, TBD. [Acknowledged, status unknown to surveyor.]
