# Planning & Zoning Comments V3 Planning Staff & Withers Ravenel

1. Continue to Provide a Written Response to ALL comments.

Response: Noted.

2. FYI - Traffic Impact Analysis (TIA) per LDO Section 8 is under way by DRMP in March 2025;

completion TBD. Response: Noted.

3. Pursuant to Applicant's notice to Staff in early June of a possible change in the scope of the proposed project, no further Review of the current submittal will occur. Applicant and Town Staff to meet asap to discuss possible new direction of the project and the necessary pathway via a Rezoning application to achieve that.

Response: This submittal proceeds with the original scope of the project.

4. FYI – LDO Section 9.2.5.B. (per Text Amendment TA-22-01) requires existing street stubs to be connected to and continued; the Board of Commissioners (BOC) cannot approve a deviation from the LDO through the Conditional Rezoning process. Any desire to NOT connect to stubbed streets shall be decided by the BOC via a process to be determined by the Town Attorney.

Response: Noted.

## Parks & Recreation Comments V1 Eddie Henderson

 Revise to label planned Sidepath and planned Bicycle Lane as "sidepath" and "bike lane." Please confirm that applicant will build these as they are shown in the Adopted Greenway and Bike plans, respectively.

Response: Concept Plan revised per comment. The lane and sidepath will be designed per the plans during the site plan/ construction drawings.

2.FYI comment – Staff would recommend the creation of a more detailed exhibit (or several) indicating the potential park locations to answer any questions from the Rolesville Boards.
