Frequently Asked Questions

How and where do I register for a program or athletic league?
Register in Town Hall or on our website, just look for "[Event/Class Registration](#)".

When can I register for programs?
For programs that require it, registration typically opens 6 to 8 weeks before the program start date and ends one week before the program start date. We have some programs that operate on a "drop-in" basis. Check the program description for details.

When can I register for an athletic league?
Athletic program registration must be done during the resident and/or open registration periods.

How can I pay for registration?
Registrations completed online must be paid for with a credit card. Registrations completed at Town Hall may be paid by credit card, cash or check.

I signed my child up for a sports league, when will the practice/game schedules be released?
The number of teams in each league is determined by how many participants register. Once registration ends, you will be notified by email as soon as the information is available. Please remember to make sure that your contact information in your REC1 account is always up to date!

What does "R and NR" stand for?
R stands for Resident and NR stands for Non-Resident. Some, but not all programs and classes have a discounted rate for Town of Rolesville residents. A "Rolesville" address does not necessarily mean that you live in the corporate limits. Please call Parks and Recreation if you have questions.

Is there a Resident discount?
Most of our programs offer a discounted rate for Town of Rolesville residents. The discount is usually \$10 to \$15 but there are some exceptions: For youth athletics, the resident discount is \$27; for camps, the discount is \$20. Resident discounts for shelters and the community center vary by space and location.

How do I rent a facility? (park shelter or community center)
Facilities can be booked and rented online by going to www.RolesvilleNC.gov, and scrolling down to "[Event/Class Registration](#)". The Community Center at Town Hall requires an additional form be submitted first. Please call 919-554-6582.

Refund Policies

- A refund request form must be submitted to Parks and Recreation staff. Forms are available online.
- Non-attendance/non-participation in a program does not entitle a participant to a refund.
- 100% refund if the department cancels the athletic league, program, class, facility rental or summer camp.
- 100% refund (minus \$5 administrative fee) in the following cases:

Athletics	No later than two weeks after first assigned team practice. After the second week of practice, refunds will not be granted. If a player is injured during the first two games of the season, a refund will be granted. After the second game, no refunds will be issued.
Program, Class or Trip	10 days prior to the start date of the program or activity
Shelter Rental	96 hours before the reservation date of the shelter. If inclement weather occurs the day of the reservation, you may request a future reservation date at no charge.
Community Center	10 days prior to the reservation date of the Community Center
Camps	14 days or more before camp week start date.



Program Scholarship Fund

Rolesville wants to ensure all its residents have equal access to recreation programs. This scholarship fund gives Rolesville residents of all ages the opportunity to apply for a scholarship that will cover 50% of the registration cost for any athletic leagues or recreation programs that cost more than \$15. These funds are supported by generous donations from our community.

Main Street Park - MSP

Located in the heart of Rolesville, Main Street Park has four rentable shelters, a gazebo, open play field, two playgrounds and over one mile of greenway trails. The shelters are first come, first served unless they have been rented ahead of time. All rentals have a two hour minumum rental requirement, charcoal grills and picnic tables (except the gazebo, which has two benches). Personal grills are not allowed, nor the use of outside entertainment (including, but not limited to, inflatables, DJ's/PA equipment, hired entertainment, pop up tents and vendors). **Alcohol and tobacco products are prohibited on Town property and please, no sidewalk chalk under the shelters and/or under covered areas. Main Street Park closes at dusk.**

Rolesville Community Center - RCC

514 Southtown Cir

The Community Center is located in the same building with Town Hall and has one dividable room that can be rented for events such as HOA meetings, birthday and graduation parties, reunions and more! The center will accomodate 293 people without chairs and tables and 133 people with all the tables and chairs set up. There is no kitchen on site. The rental time must include your set-up and clean up and there is a two hour minimum rental period. Included with the hourly rate are 96 chairs and 12 eight-foot folding tables. You can upgrade to 72 inch round tables at a fee of \$8 per table, in addition to the hourly rate.

Where is Parks and Recreation in Rolesville headed? Well it turns out, just to the end of N. Main Street on Hwy 401! The Town of Rolesville is in the middle of a multi-year process to build the Town’s newest recreation area, The Farm park (working title, likely to change). The master plan for this 116 acre park was completed in 2020 and the construction drawing phase is in full swing, with 30% construction drawings completed summer 2021.

The park will consist of a combination of recreation facilities including baseball/softball, and multipurpose fields as well as indoor and outdoor event spaces, dog park and agritourism area. The master planning process has revealed The Farm park has the potential to be a regional destination for a diversity of users.

A rich archaeological and cultural history combined with athletic offerings and iconic event space, positions The Farm park as a premier destination for families, tournament players, performers and artists, history lovers, nature seekers, and event planners.
